Application Submission:

A completed Application, the examination fee for the Academy of Gp Orthodontics' Tier Advancement Program, case material with case presentation documentation must be submitted to Academy Headquarters 8 weeks prior to the date of the examination.

Criteria: Earned 225 hour – credits in an approved seminar, post-graduate course or professional meeting or completes a hands-on course with an additional 50 hours as approved by the Academy of Gp Orthodontics.

Present a minimum of 5 completed orthodontically treated cases; according to standards set by the examining board. The cases should be varying in degrees of difficulty. Suggestions: Class I Crowded Case; Class I Bimaxillary Protrusion; Class II Division; Class II Division 1 High Angle (S-NA: GO _GN 40 degrees+)

Examination: Oral and written examination before the examiners of the Academy of Gp Orthodontics with 80% of the completed cases utilizing the Tip-Edge® System or Differential Straight-Arch® Technique and 20% of the completed cases with the candidate's choice of technique (10/8/2006).

Annual meeting attendance: Recommend attendance.

Membership: Maintained 3 years of continuous membership in AGpO.

Upon passing the examination the participant is recognized as a Fellow of the Academy of Gp Orthodontics. The recipient is issued a Fellow Award during the Annual Meeting at the Members' Luncheon, receives a photo and an article to submit to their local newspaper.

Membership Renewal: Renewal of this membership status of Fellow, may be granted only following a review by the Academy of Gp Orthodontics' Board of Directors at the end of the respective membership period.
